

Day of Discovery

Hosted by BOLT Tridel Corporation & George Brown College,
Centre for Construction & Engineering Technologies

When: Thursday October 24, 2019 from 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM

Where: Starts and ends at George Brown College, Casa Loma Campus, 160 Kendall Ave, Toronto ON. Participants will visit Tridel's unique Avani Phase 2 Project. We will be travelling to the higher floors on a hoist so **individuals who fear heights are advised not to register for this experience.**

Who: This experience is available to a limited number of young adults between the ages of 18 and 29, who are interested in learning more about a career in Construction including apprenticeship training and post-secondary educational opportunities **Note: There are limited opportunities available and registration is on a first come first serve basis. Note: Youth must be referred by an agency.**

Goal: The goal of the day is to provide participants with the unique opportunity to visit an active construction site, to tour a project under different stages of construction, to observe the trades at work and to participate in a hands on activity at the Centre for Construction and Engineering Technologies at George Brown College.

Agenda

- Participants meet at George Brown College, Casa Loma Campus at 8:00AM for registration.
- George Brown will organize a hands-on construction related activity at the Casa Loma Campus after which time the participants will board a bus to travel to Tridel's Avani construction site.
- Safety procedures will be reviewed on-site before commencing the tours
- At the end of the day, participants will be bused to the Casa Loma Campus and will evaluate the day and have an opportunity to register for Job Shadowing.

What is provided?

- A loan of construction boots and a hard hat that **must** be worn on site
- Transportation to and from the construction site
- Lunch and refreshments

What Happens After the Day of Discovery?

At the end of the day, those interested in spending more time on a construction site are invited to apply for a two-week Job Shadowing experience.

What is Job Shadowing?

- This is a two week experience on a Tridel construction site
- It provides an opportunity for participants to explore a variety of construction trades and management and consulting professions
- Registration for this experience will take place at the end of the Day of Discovery
- An interview will be scheduled after Registration
