FINANCIAL AWARDS

BOLT Financial Awards are offered to full-time students pursuing construction related college or university programs. Successful candidates receive \$3,000 to \$5,000 for the school year.

On average, BOLT provides 45 scholarships totaling \$165,000 per academic year, both directly through the BOLT Foundation and through our post-secondary and community partners.

BOLT helps connect youth interested in pursuing a career in the skilled trades with the right skilled training so they can start their apprenticeship.

BOLT Women in Construction Scholarship

To promote retention in the industry, this scholarship provides apprentices with financial support of \$500 for in-class training and a mentor to help provide additional support and career advice. In partnership with SOY and OBCT.
